### History

- Project was created 8th of August 2016.
- Used to have only 26 voluntary helpers.
- · Started without school building.
- Were taught privately at home.
- · -> Now they're taught at school
- regular school.(not specifically created for them)
- · Used to not have rooms for childcare
- · -> now they have
- · big challenge to finance everything.
- many organisations are working together.

#### Volunteers

- · Volunteers played a big role since beginning.
- · -> had idea for a "language school".
- Do free time activities together.
- Come to school from other cities, just to help.
- During classes they offer i.e. sewing clubs and art clubs in order to get donations.
- Provide stationery and books.
- Help people enter the projects (i.e. VW).
- Offer childcare for the children of the refugees.
- There are no criteria for being a helper.

#### Certification/Education

- Different levels of education (reach from A1 - B1, CEFR)
- They take final exams in order to get regular certificates
- -> Volunteers bring them to these exams
- Exams are taken in Wolfenbüttel
- · Volkswagen supports these programs
- -> Internships, Apprenticeships, Jobs
- · School also looks out for jobs
- Certification and education is the main focus of the project
- Refugees stress the importance of the concept of "giving and taking"

#### Problems and chances

- Some of them have a very dramatic past (family in other countries) thus making it harder for them to settle
- The money the project receives and the duration of funding remains uncertain
- Some leave their work for going to school
  - Paperwork (i.e. requiring certificates instead of focusing on individual strengths)
    - Some got really bad education in their home countries
