A recorded mock debate:

A trinational project about integrating refugees on the labor market

French, Italian and German experts and politicians meet during a conference to develop a common project for the labor market to integrate refugees.

In general: For a successful mock debate game, it is important to discuss the theme from the perspective of your role. Therefore, the objective is not to discuss the personal opinions of participants, but to engage in your role.

The setting:

France, Germany and Italy as members of the European Union want to start a trilateral project to improve the integration of refugees on the labor market. Therefore, coalitions with different experts of the three countries meet in an online conference to decide about common policy guidelines for the integration/ to create a common integration's project for the labor market in a trilateral cooperation.

For the conference there are three expert delegations of the three countries invited. All of them have different ideas, how the integration of refugees can be succeeded on the labor market. The goal is to find different cooperation with other experts to implement your own idea in the project/ in the policy guidelines. To convince the other experts of your own idea every delegation gives a passionate speech in the beginning of the meeting.

Please, get dressed in the appropriate clothing for the simulation game. The French delegation in blue, the German delegation in red and the Italian one in green. Write your role name on a nameplate.

Step 1:

For preparation of your role as members of a French/ German/ Italian delegation try to answer the following questions in general:

- 1. What do you know about the political view of your country about refugees and their integration?
- 2. How is the current status on the labor market in your country
 - a) in general?
 - b) for refugees?
- 3. Which problems as well as chances have arisen?
- 4. Are there also some changes on the labor market during the refugee crisis?

Use all your information about real projects you know, but also your knowledge from the other mobilities.

Step 2:

Now, create your delegation. Therefore,

- 1. Create a main position to the integration of refugees on the labor market. This can be an extreme liberal position or an extreme traditional-national opinion. Answer among others the following questions:
 - a) Do you support an integration of refugees on the labor market?
 - b) Do you think a successful integration of refugees is a change or a barrier for the domestic economy?
 - c) Which advantages and which disadvantages do you see for your country?
 - d) Which kind of problems do you see for a successful integration?

Step 3:

- 1. Think about the members of you delegation and create different roles. Think especially about their profession why are they experts in this delegation? And how affects their profession their positions/ opinions?
- 2. Create at least concrete 4-5 roles. The other ones in your group are nameless support during the simulation game they should also join the discussion and speak.
